How does Talking Connections work?

When we receive your referral you will receive a letter of confirmation stating that you have been placed on the waiting list of approximately 12 weeks.

Appointments are offered to clients in the order in which they are received. There are no priority appointments.

Cost

Our service utilises a number of professional counsellors who volunteer their time to help support individuals in need of counselling services at a cost of £10 per session.

MHM Wales is a charity that aims to support everybody who comes to us for help. This is a non-profit making service and we only charge this small fee to help recover the admin, utility and volunteer costs of each session.
